

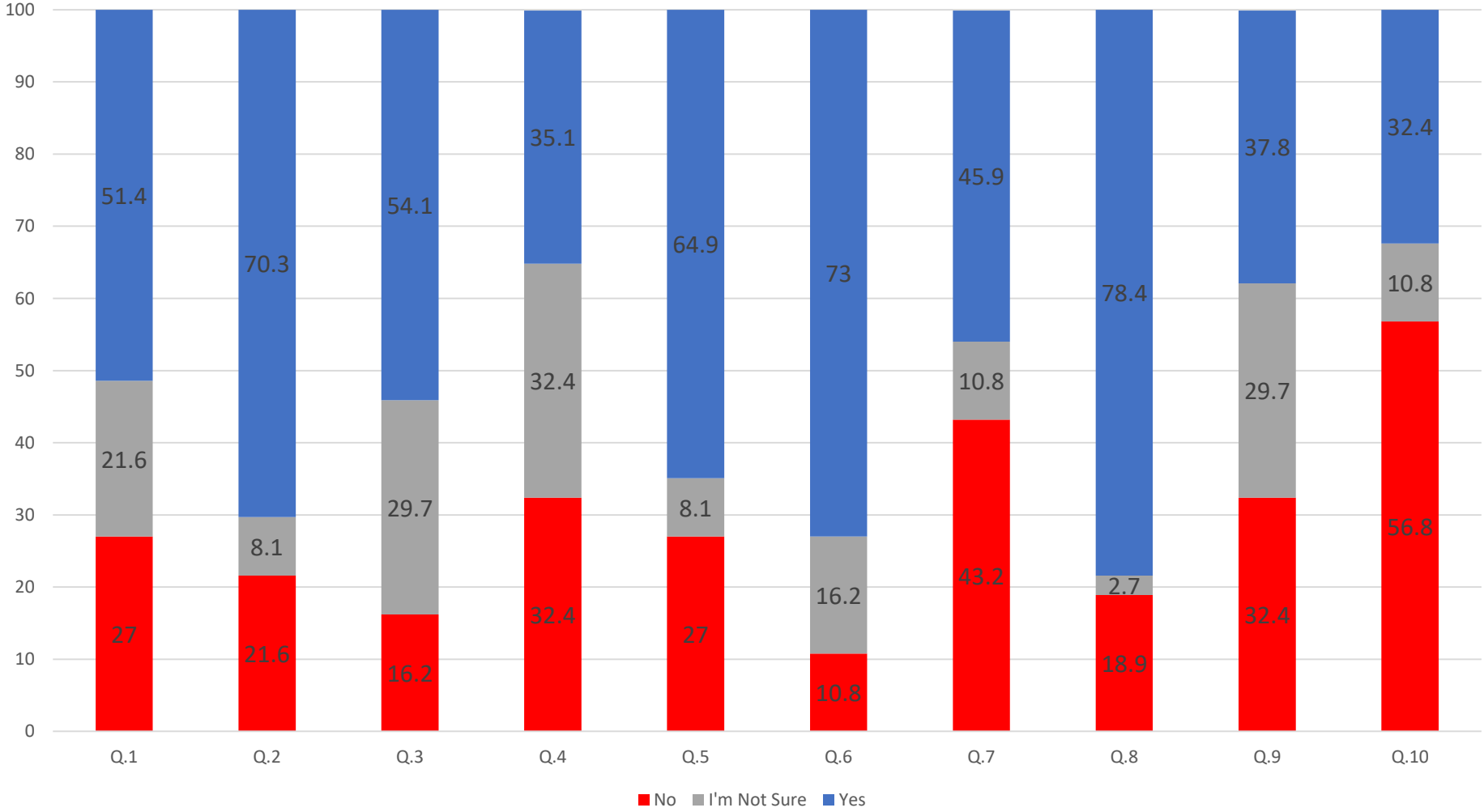

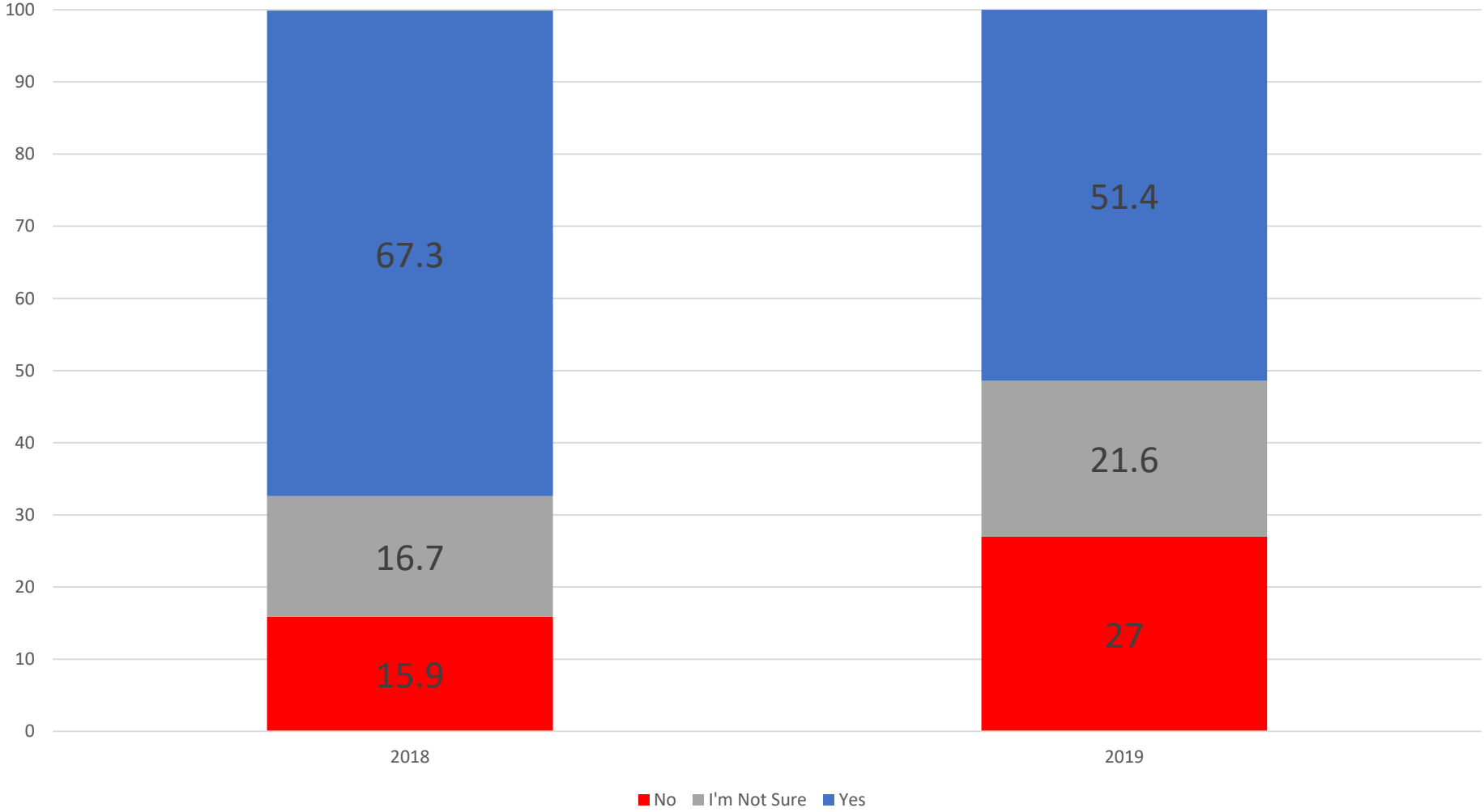

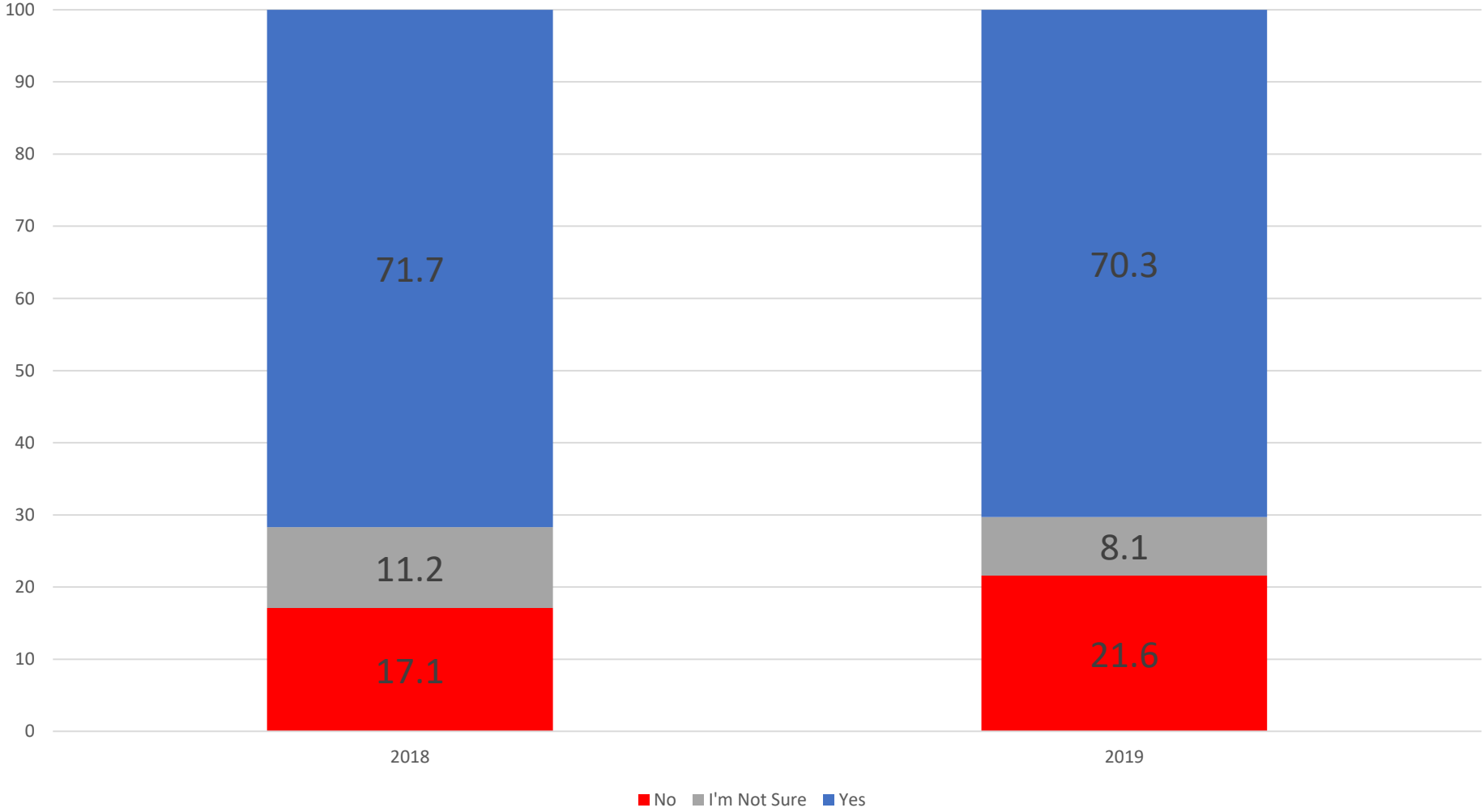
Composite Results: 37 Participants



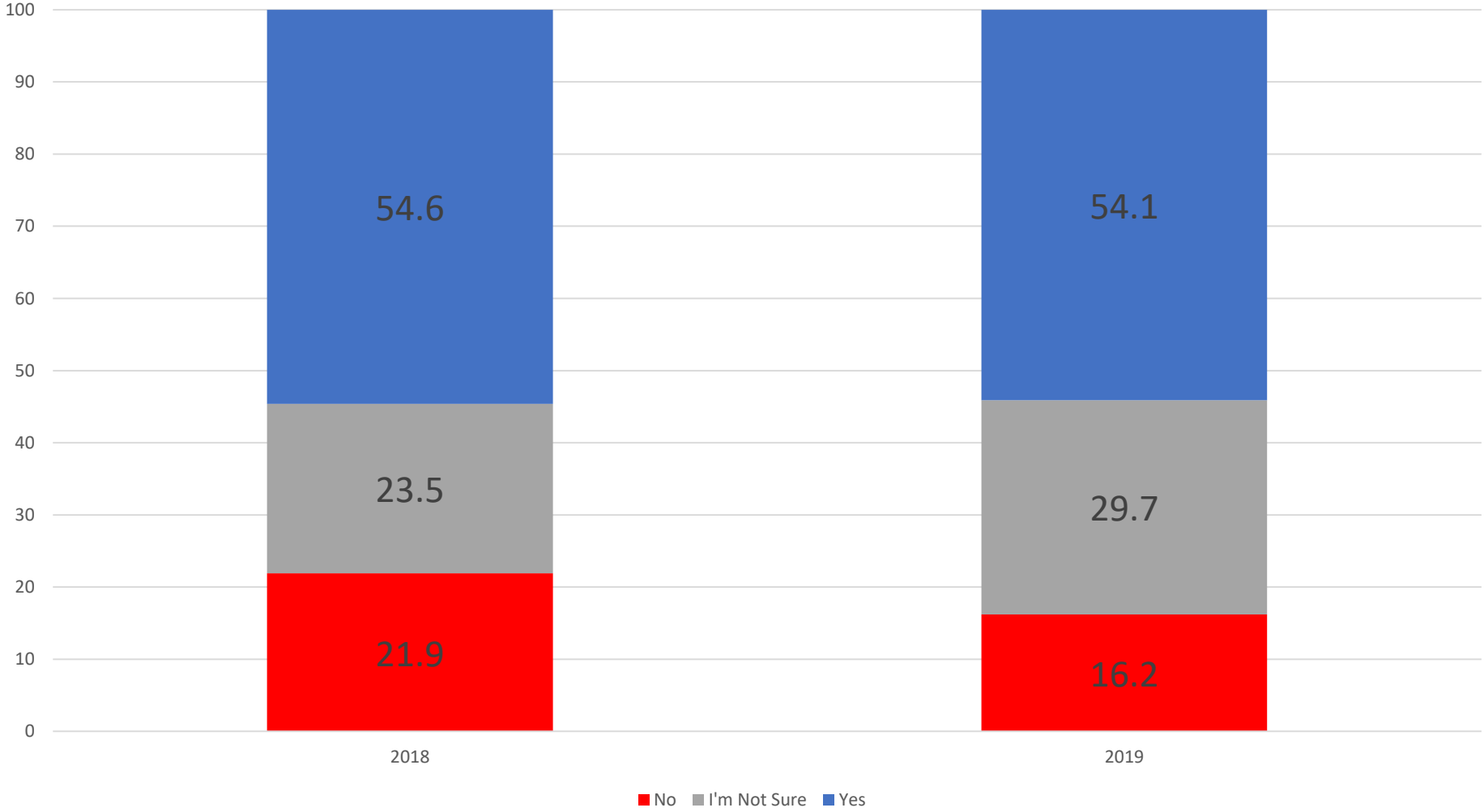
Q1: I feel safe in my school.



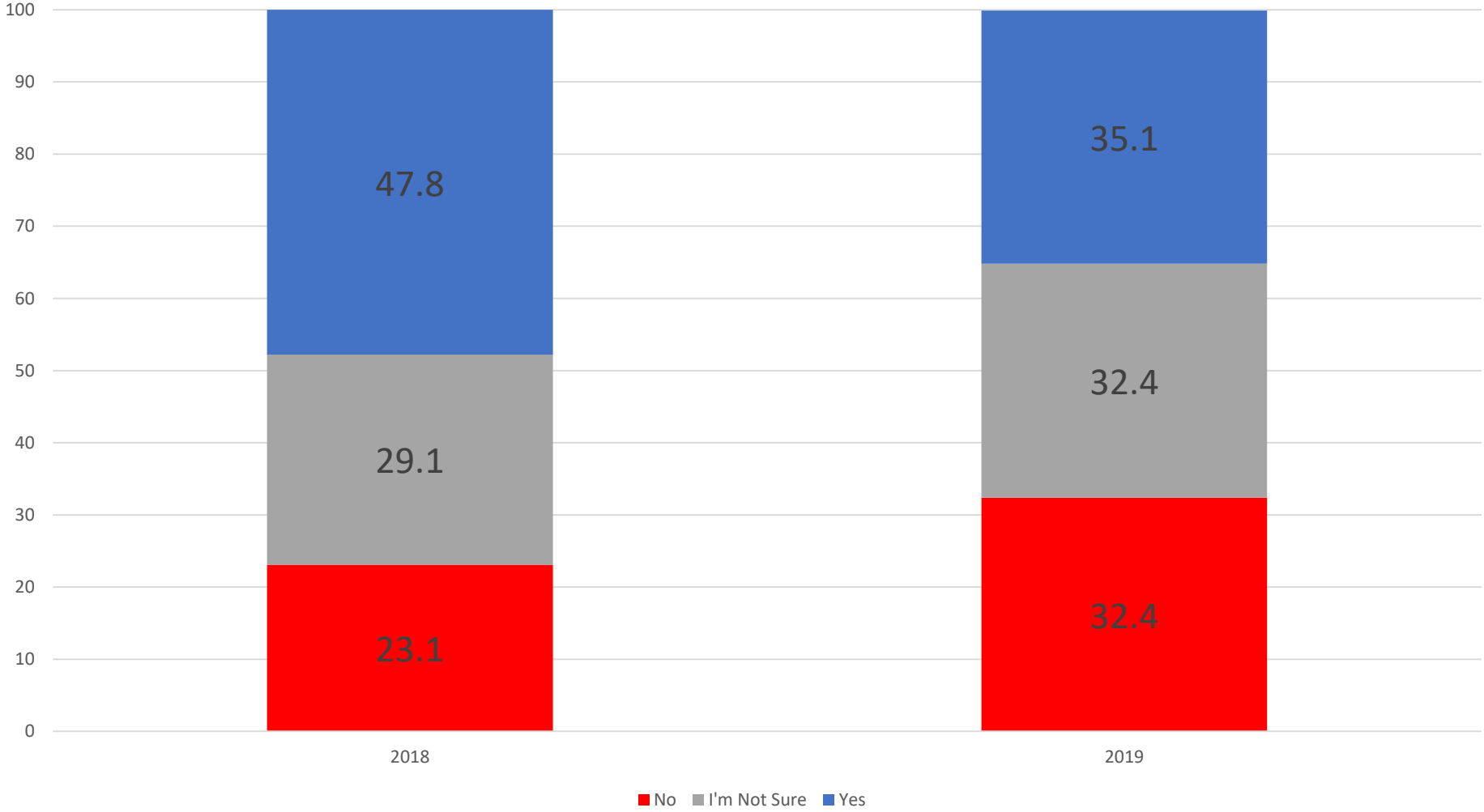
Q2: I feel that my teachers treat me with respect.



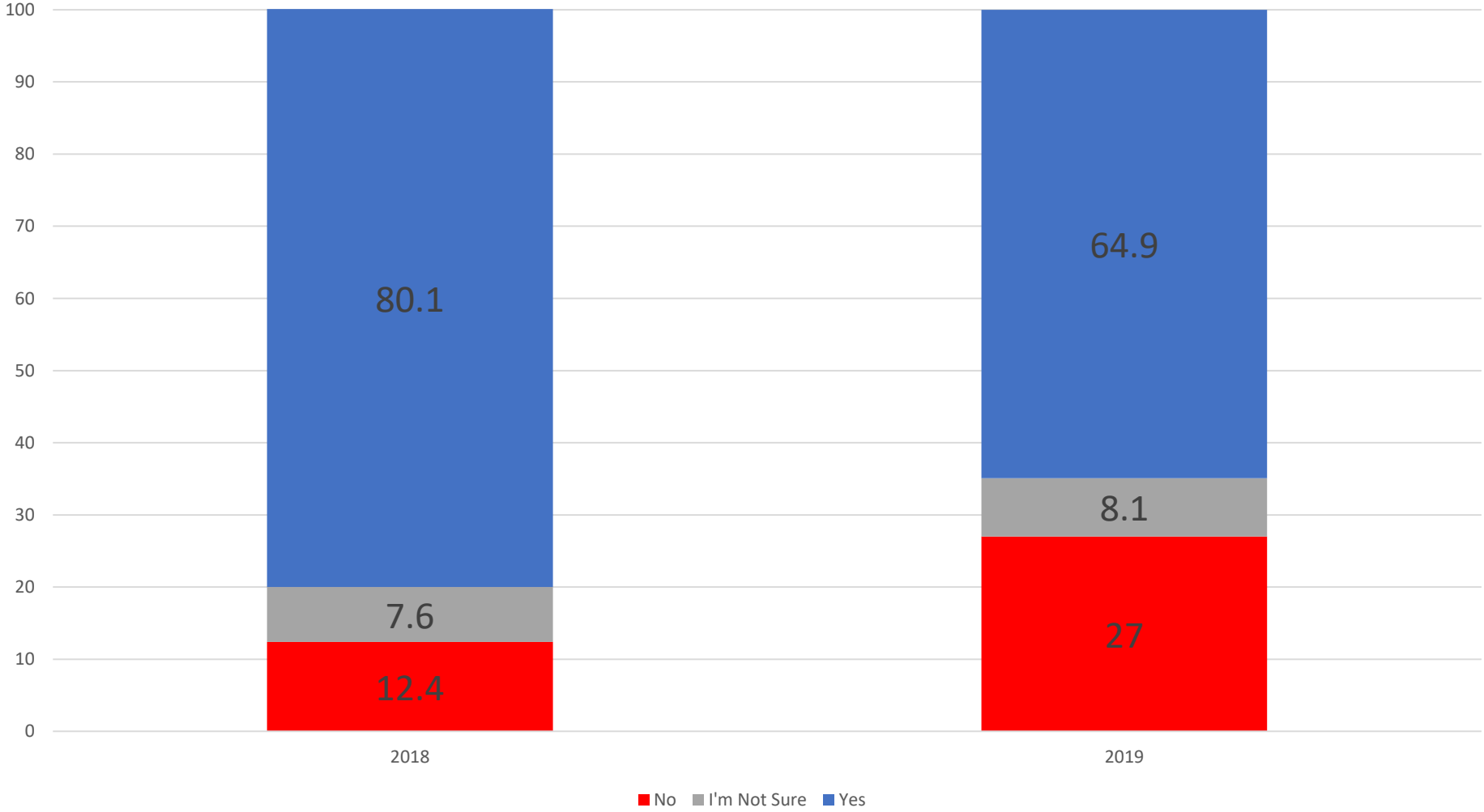
Q3: If I got in trouble, I was treated with respect. (class discipline, office-referrals, suspensions, expulsions, in-school suspensions, etc.).



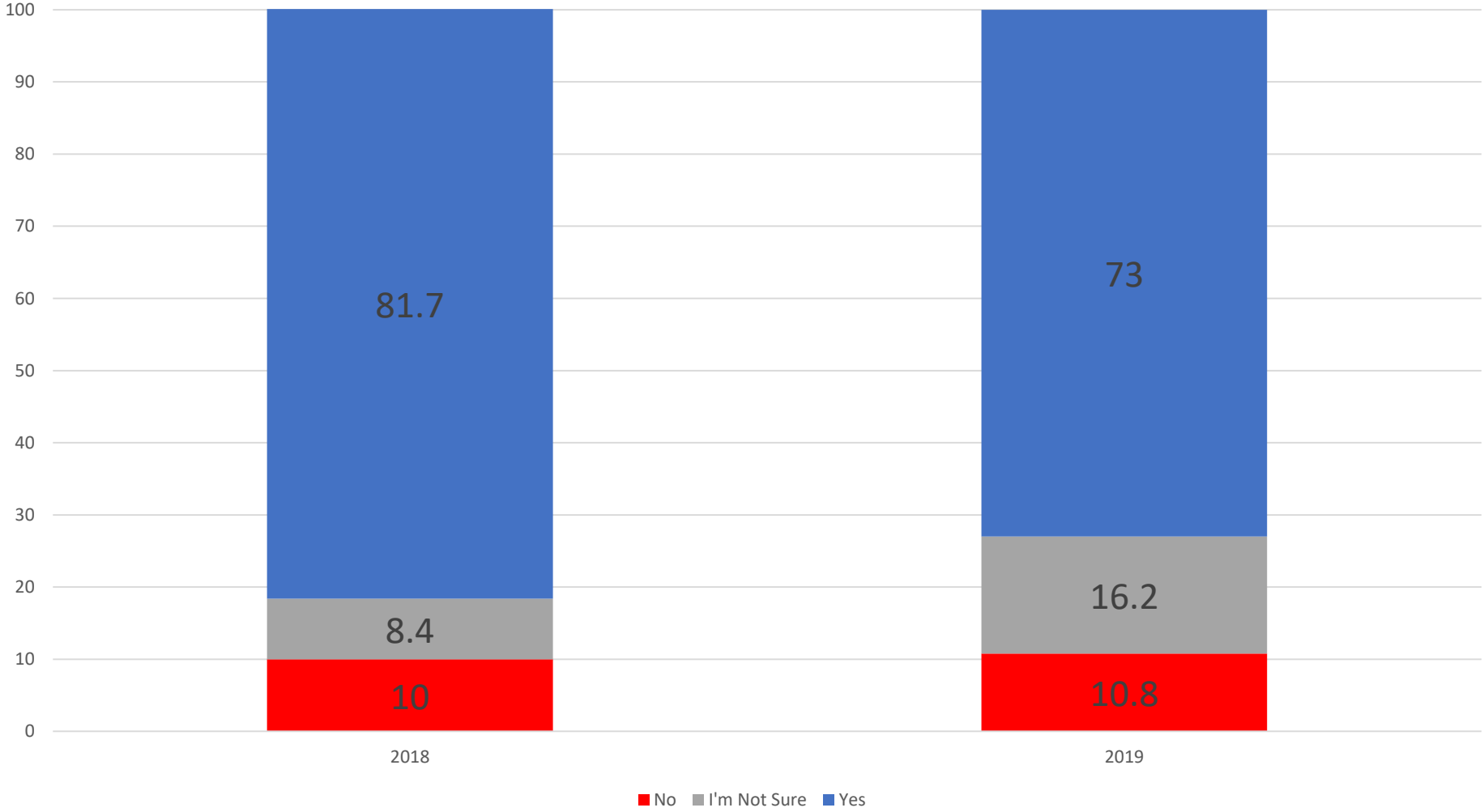
Q4: Disciplined students are treated with respect in my school (class discipline, office-referrals, suspensions, expulsions, in-school suspensions, etc.).



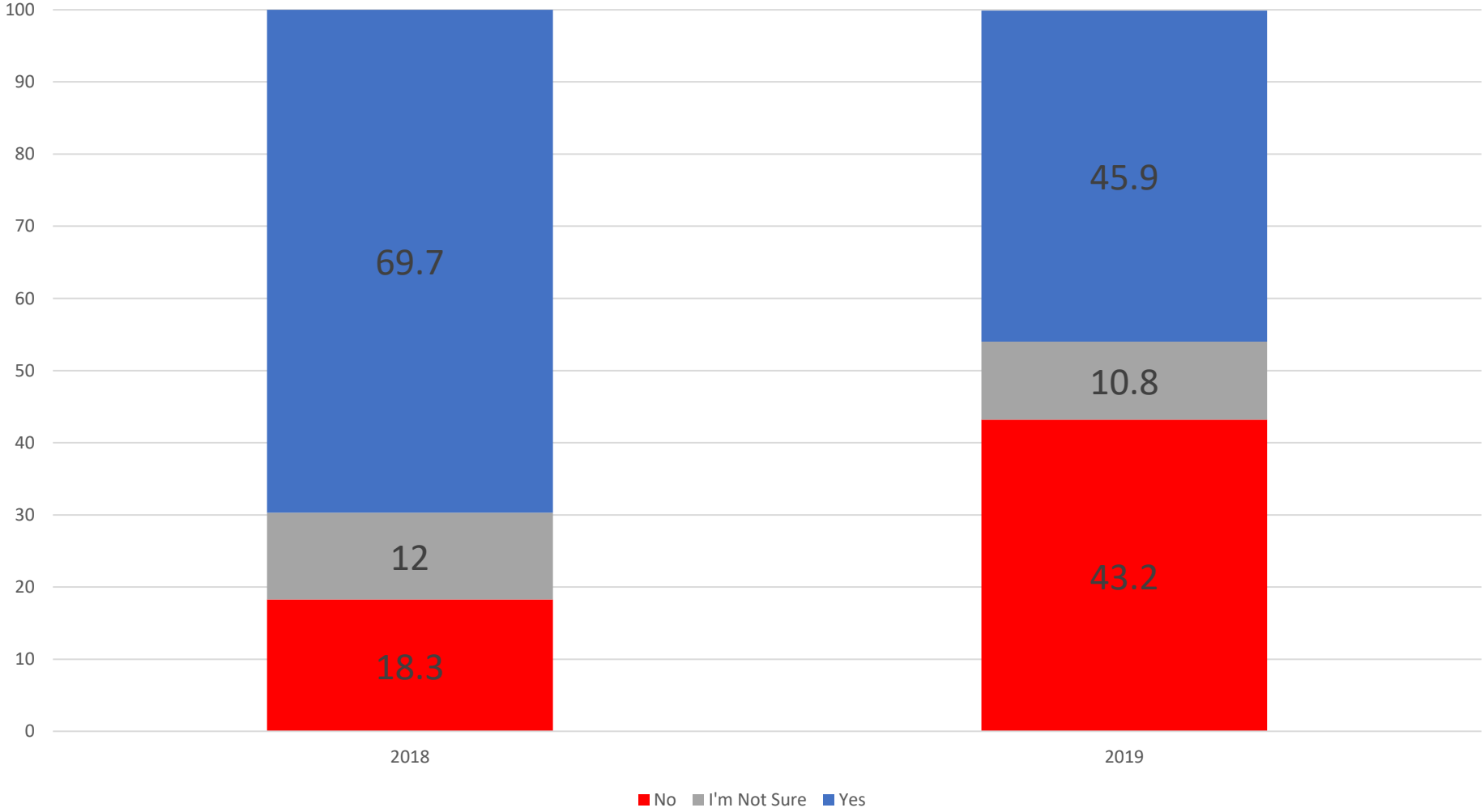
Q5: My school has prepared me in case there is an emergency (fire, tornado, intruders, etc.).



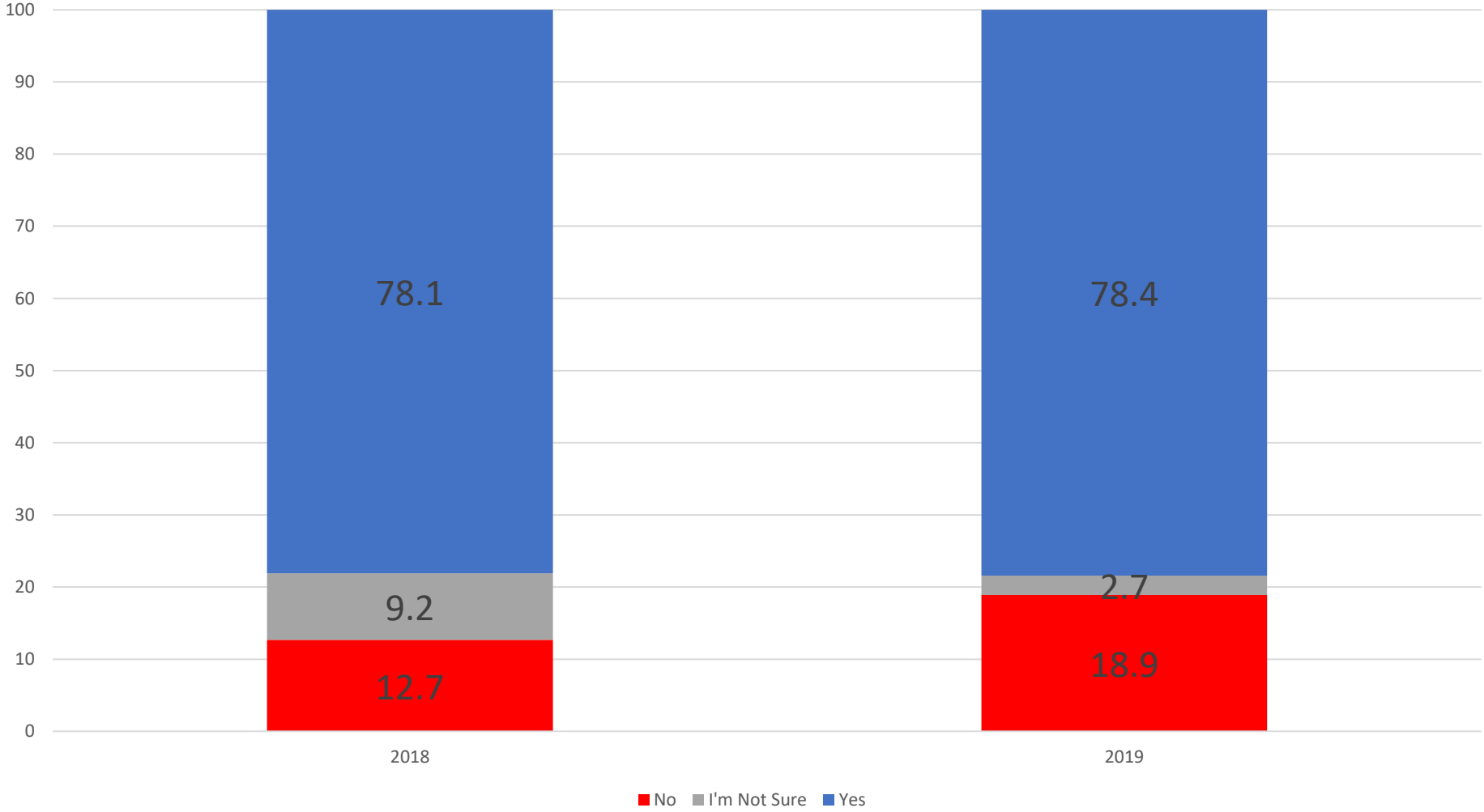
Q6: If I have a problem, there is an adult in my school I can talk to.



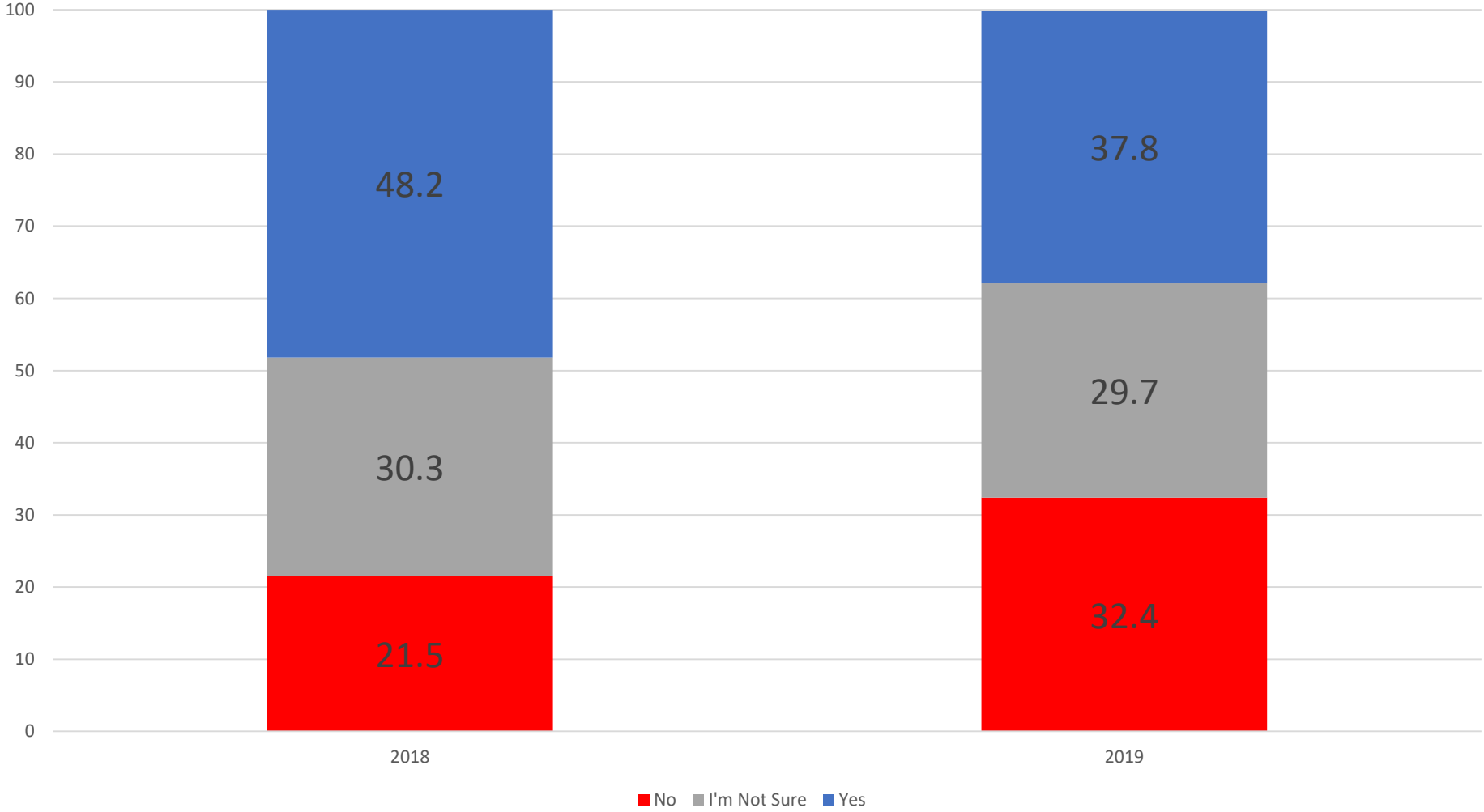
Q7: Adults in my school supervise us at all times to keep us safe.
