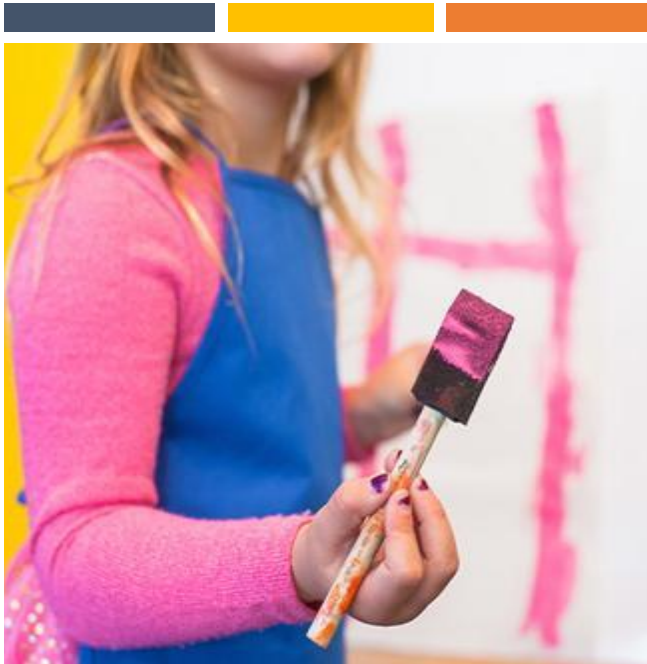


### RES teachers will strive to:

- Keep contact information up-to-date for school records
